## You know the children best: let them struggle for a bit, but above all, teach them that it takes hard work to learn.

The most effective feedback is not marking but discussing - the discussion does not need to recorded, future work will show it had impact. Specific subjects may have additional feedback methods but this is a summary of our core methods to meet the needs of all our learners.

Children like to know how they did and what they need to do next – we are clear, precise and visual.

## The Feedback Pack:

- Smiley coaster for your tea, coffee etc.....
- Orange highlighter working towards the We Are Learning To (WALT)
- Green highlighter WALT achieved
- Yellow highlighter mistake / error (specific or margin depending on independence)
- Pink highlighter positive
- Reward stickers
- Blue pen only if necessary. Written comments will always model good handwriting. Ticks and dots never crosses
- Sweeties reward yourself for a job well done!
